Beginners Encouraged & Welcome - Biathlon Equipment Provided

Come and learn the challenging sport of Winter Biathlon, combining Nordic Skiing with Rifle Marksmanship. Biathlon is open to all athletes age 9 and over who have completed a **MANDATORY biathlon safety clinic**. A safety clinic will be offered Saturday, Dec 29<sup>th</sup> at 1pm (after the Ski Rodeo) at the Mazama Ranch House chicken coop & move to the biathlon range. Pre-registration for the safety clinic is required and costs \$10.00 per person.

**Saturday Dec 29th:** 1:00pm Safety Clinic (pre-registration is required) Mazama Ranch House chicken coop  
Training opportunity for experienced biathletes with their own rifles.

**Sunday Dec 30<sup>th</sup>:** 8:30am - 9:00am Registration & bib pick-up  
10:00 - 11:00 Rifle Zeroing  
11:15 Pursuit Format Biathlon Race (Individual interval starts)  
1:15 Awards (or approx. 30min after the last finisher)  
1:30 - 2:30 Open range coaching, questions & answers

The race distance depends on age & ability. See entry form for age classes with distances & shooting bouts. Only .22LR caliber manual feed (bolt or lever action) rifles with detachable 5 shot magazines are allowed under biathlon rules. Rifles will be available for anyone that does not have their own. Please check the section on the entry form if you need to use a club rifle. Only standard velocity .22 caliber ammunition is allowed. No hollow point, jacketed or high velocity ammo allowed. Ammunition will be available to buy at the range if needed.

**Safety Clinic** All first time participants are required to attend one pre-race biathlon safety clinic. At the clinic, the rules and safety procedures will be examined as well as proper shooting positions, rifle operation and safety. Contact race organizer if you are new to the sport and need to take this clinic. Pre-registration is required & costs \$10.00 per person.

**Race Registration Fees** - Fee is \$25 for 19yr & over , \$15.00 for 9-18 years (see entry form). Prices include trail pass. Pre-registration is preferred. Registration tent will be at the range on race day for bib pick-up etc. US Biathlon membership is required (\$50-adult, \$25-junior) or you can be a member for a day for \$10. You can go to [www.usbiathlon.com/forms/memberform.html](http://www.usbiathlon.com/forms/memberform.html) for membership forms & fees or they will be available at the time of registration.

**Directions** The range is a 1.5km ski east from the Mazama trailhead. There will be a snowmobile shuttle available for non-skiers needing help out to the range. Please contact race organizers if you will need a shuttle.

## Washington Biathlon Cup Season Points

For the 2007 - 2008 Winter Biathlon Season, the International Biathlon Union race points system will be in effect. Points a racer receives from each of the seven races will be totaled at the end of the March 9<sup>th</sup> race and the male and female biathletes with the most points will be named **WASHINGTON CUP** Champions. There will be one "throw-out" allowed, so points will be totaled from any 6 of the 7 races in the series. Race dates are: Dec. 30, at Mazama; Jan. 12-13; Feb. 23-24; and March 8-9, all at Stevens Pass Nordic Center. See [www.wabiathlon.org](http://www.wabiathlon.org)
